

The Roman System for Designating Years (A.U.C.)

A.U.C. - *ab urbe condita*, "from the founding of the city"

Converting Roman years to our years	
If Roman A.U.C. date is 753 or less	$754 - X$
If Roman A.U.C. date is 754 or greater	$X - 753$

Converting our years to Roman years	
If our date is B.C.	$754 - X$
If our date is A.D.	$X + 753$

Roman Numerals

I	=	1
V	=	5
X	=	10
L	=	50
C	=	100
D	=	500
M	=	1000
