

Imperfect and Pluperfect Subjunctive

Regular Verb

	Active	Passive
Imperfect	mitteret infinitive + active ending <i>he was sending / he sent</i>	mitterētur infinitive + passive ending <i>he was (being) sent</i>
Pluperfect	mīssisset perfect stem + isse + active ending <i>he had sent</i>	missus esset 4 th principal part + <i>essem</i> , etc. <i>he had been sent</i>

Deponent Verb

Imperfect	cōnārētur Pretend the verb has an active infinitive, and add passive ending <i>he was trying / he tried</i>
Pluperfect	cōnātus esset last principal part + <i>essem</i> , etc. <i>he had tried</i>

cōnārī → cōnārētur
 verērī → verērētur
 sequī → sequerētur
 ingredī → ingrederētur
 adorīrī → adorīrētur

Change the deponent infinitive back to an "active" infinitive, then add a passive ending
