Regular Verb

	Active	Passive
Present	dūcam "she wears a giant diamond" + active endings	dūcar "she wears a giant diamond" + passive endings
Imperfect	dūcerem present active infinitive + active endings	dūcerer present active infinitive + passive endings
Perfect	dūxerim perfect stem + -erim, -eris, -erit, -erimus, -eritis, -erint (very similar to future perfect indicative)	ductus sim 4 th p.p. + sim, sis, sit, simus, sitis, sint
Pluperfect	dūxissem perfect active infinitive + active ending	ductus essem 4 th principal part + essem, esses, esset, essemus, essetis, essent

Deponent Verb

	Passive Forms, Active Meanings
Present	sequar "she wears a giant diamond" (passive ending)
Imperfect	sequerer what would the present active infinitive be? + passive ending
Perfect	secūtus sim last principal part + sim, sis, sit, simus, sitis, sint
Pluperfect	secūtus essem last principal part + essem, esses, esset, essemus, essetis, essent
