

Result Clauses

A sentence with a result clause will have three essential components

1	2	3
one of the following words in the main clause:	<i>ut</i> translated “that (as a result)...”	subjunctive verb in the result clause

adeō, so, so much, to such an extent

ita, thus, in such a way

sīc, thus, in this way

tālis, such

tam, so

tantus, -a, -um, so great

tantum, so much

tot, so many

Example:

Puer erat tam perterritus
The boy was so frightened

ut
that (as a result)

aufugeret.
he ran away.
